

# FORGET ME NOT FIELDS

## NATURAL BURIAL GROUND

### OPTIONS FOR PET OWNERS INFORMATION SHEET

At Forget Me Not Fields we allow the interment of the ashes of both humans and pets. There is a dedicated separate section for pets and their owners so do let us know in advance if you'd particularly like a plot in this area.

We have two main options as detailed below-

#### OPTION 1

The first option for the ashes of a pet is to purchase an individual ashes plot for them. For this option you'd pay for the plot price plus the interment fee as specified on our price list. Each plot may be marked by one slate plaque measuring 300 x 300mm recessed into the ground. Adjacent plots could be purchased for yourself or other pets.

#### OPTION 2

We do offer an alternative for the ashes of pets which can work out to be more cost effective. Each ashes plot may hold only one urn and may only have one memorial plaque per plot too.

It is possible to pre-purchase a plot for yourself for future use but have up to 4 sets of pet ashes buried in the plot (one in each quarter) using the under-the-turf method. The ashes of pets could be interred using this method before your death with your urn interred years later in the centre.

The downside with this method is that pets can't be memorialised in the same way (as only one plaque per plot is permitted) and multiple urns can't be buried- only ashes scattered under the turf.

The main advantage of this method is that it is very cost effective if you have lots of pets and you can all be together eventually.

#### COSTS

Please see our separate pricelist for details of the current options and associated prices. The plot purchaser and interment fees are the same for both the ashes of humans and pets.

Advance plot prices are payable now at current prices. The interment fees are payable at the time of need using the prices at that time.

#### OTHER THINGS TO CONSIDER

Burial plots and the right to scatter ashes may be purchased in advance by those wishing to put their affairs in order ahead of time. Family members may pre-purchase adjacent plots to ensure they are buried together when the time comes.
